Donations may be given in her honor to Antioch Baptist church or the Alzheimer’s Association Alabama chapter.

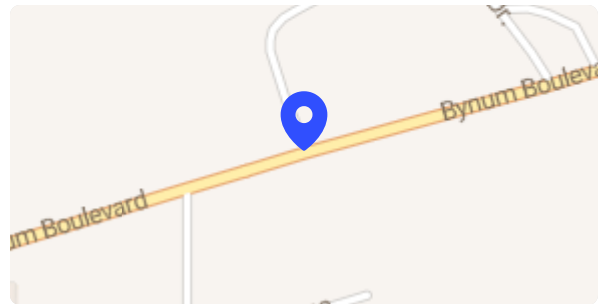

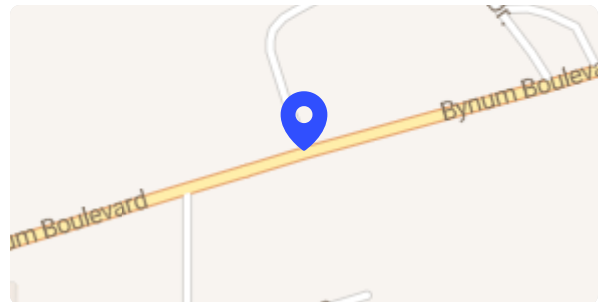
