In lieu of flowers donations can be made to the Oxford Senior Citizens Center or Meadowbrook Baptist Church.

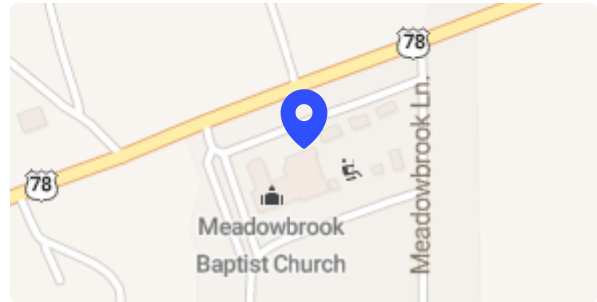

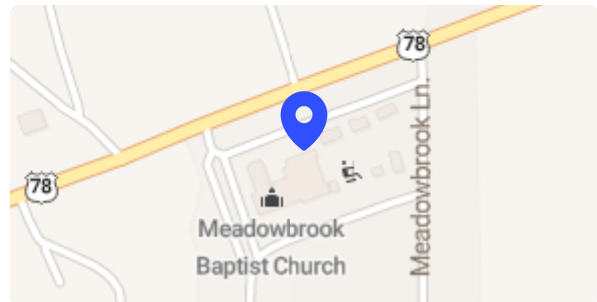
