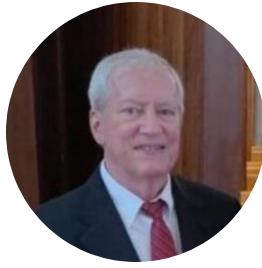

In lieu of flowers, the family requests that memorial contributions be made to the American Cancer Society.

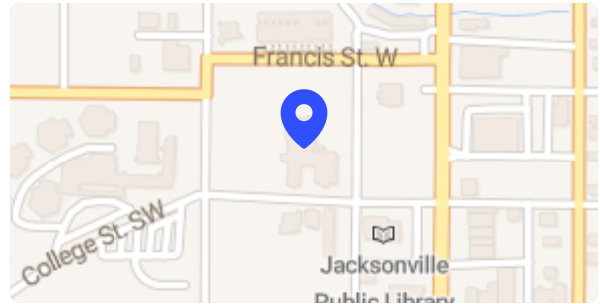

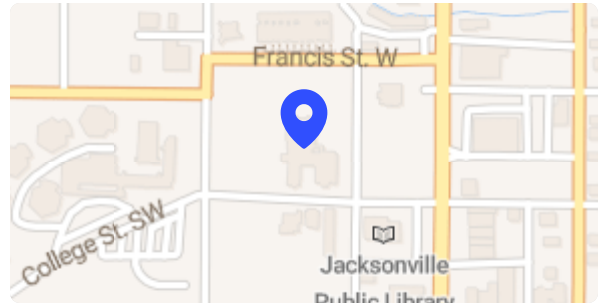
