The Cambron family appreciates your thoughts and prayers as they navigate through their journey of grief together.

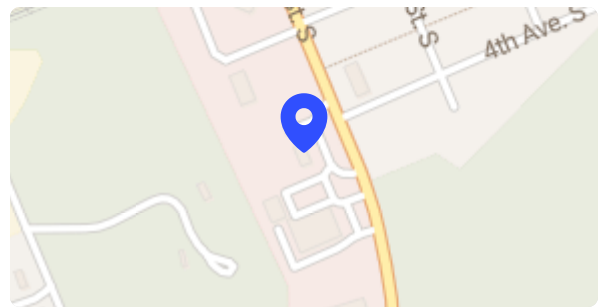

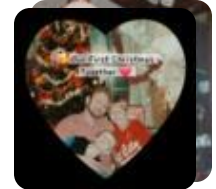
**Terri Denty** posted:
